Details on Zoom Operations	<p>Before we get started, I would like to provide you, the audience, with some guidelines about the contest.</p> <p>Online participants can control the view of the contest by selecting either the Gallery View, which shows all the participants <u>or</u> Speaker View, which highlights the active speaker. On a desktop/laptop computer, click the button in the top right corner to alternate between "Gallery View" and "Speaker View."</p> <p>Let's try that now.</p> <p>While the contest is underway, please remain muted and DO NOT TURN ON YOUR VIDEO. Our Producer(s) <Producer(s)> will mute and turn off video of any participants that accidentally turned on their video or unmute themselves.</p> <p>If necessary, the Producer(s) may remove audience members if they are disruptive. If you have a question or concerns, privately chat with the/a Producer.</p> <p>Audience members at a live event must not enter or leave the speaking room during a speech. Please enter or leave the room only during the one minute of silence between speakers.</p> <p>Please give your full attention to the contestants and limit distractions. 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<p>Details on Zoom Operations</p>	<p>After each speaker finishes, there will be one minute of silence to allow the judges to mark their ballots. After the final speaker in a contest finishes, we will observe an indefinite period of silence.</p> <p>There is NO audio or video recording permitted without prior consent of the contestants.</p> <p>Protests about speeches may ONLY be made by the Contestants or Judges and must be presented to either the Contest Chair or the Chief Judge before the winners are announced. Both the Judges and the contestants have the protocol to do this in an online format.</p> <p>I would like to let you know that the speaking area has been defined as the visible area of the camera.</p> <p>Timing of the Humorous Speeches are as follows: The minimum time is 4 minutes 30 seconds, the green will be shown at 5 minutes, yellow at 6 minutes, red at 7 minutes and the maximum time is 7 minutes and 30 seconds.</p> <p>Can I please ask the timer <Timer> to display the green, yellow and red background colors for the contestants?</p>	<p>Toastmaster</p>	<p>Mute <All Attendees> Unmute <Toastmaster></p>
